Do not leave your child unless the Coach is present inside the hall as Ladywood Leisure Centre may cancel our hall booking at short notice and we cannot always contact all parents in time.

MEDICATION

Please ensure that any medication, inhalers, epipens, etc is sent along with your child each time they come to table tennis in a named bag/box and handed to the Coach who will keep it safe, and accessible, until the end of play when your child should collect it again. Children should be able to administer these items themselves and you must ensure that our Coaches are familiar with such items before leaving them. Bringing these items to each session could prevent serious incidents from arising and the need to seek emergency help.

GENERAL

Sportswear, especially footwear, should be worn at each session and a drink of water should be brought along. Children with long hair should tie it up before playing.

We do not accept any responsibility for children until commencement of play at the appropriate time.

Table Tennis bats are provided by the club if you do not own one. If you wish to order a bat through the club, please contact Greig or Tom who can assist with that.

CODE OF CONDUCT
